***Duffle Bag with items listed below due Friday, May 24th @ 8:15 am.

Clothing

- ___ Warm Jacket/ Winter Jacket
- ___ 3 sweatshirts
- ___ 2 pairs of tennis shoes (one pair often gets wet at tide pools)
- ___ 3-4 pairs of long pants
- ___ 6 pairs of socks & underwear (this includes 2 extra of each-just in case)
- ___ warm pajamas
- ___ 3-4 shirts
(short and long sleeved for layering)
- ___ Swimming suit
- ___ warm knit or fleece hat

(this is a must for staying warm at night)
- ___ optional: lightweight gloves, long underwear, shorts

Personal Items

- ___ toothbrush & toothpaste
- ___ comb or brush
- ___ Deodorant-stick only, no sprays
- ___ 2 towels, wash cloth
- ___ Shampoo, soap
- ___ chap stick, sun block, insect repellent
(Go easy on Deet with kids>>less than 25%)
- ___ \$1.00 in quarters for shower
